

Chairman Rick Kochel called to order the Earl Township Board of Supervisors meeting, held on **Thursday October 28, 2021**, at 7:00 a.m. The following were present: Supervisors Rick Kochel, Ray Martin and Tom Plitt and Road Master Lee Zimmerman.

Rick made a **motion to conditionally execute the Echo Housing Agreement to allow David and Sadie Glick, on-farm housing and add a temporary secondary residence on 1077 West Main Street, New Holland, owned by Jacob and Mary Glick. The approval is contingent upon compliance with the Zoning regulations and ability to obtain a building permit.** Ray seconded the motion and all voted yes.

Ray made a **motion to execute the Reimbursement of Professional Services Agreement for Homestead Outdoor Products, 905 West Main Street, relative to the Land Development Planning process.** Rick seconded the motion and all voted yes.

Ray made a **motion to approve the Short Term Rental (STR) Permit/License Application form, the Inspection form and the fee schedule as follows:**

- a. **\$50.00 non-refundable deposit**
- b. **\$100.00 Permit/License fee**
- c. **\$80.00 Re-Inspection fee per visit (for failed inspections)**
- d. **\$120.00 Annual Inspection fee.**

Tom seconded and all voted yes.

The proposed 2022 Liquid Fuels and General Funds budget were reviewed and discussed.
